

## KinderTrack – Enabling WPI Settings

WPI stands for Warn, Prevent, Ignore. The actions of this setting can be edited for the pages when information is saved.

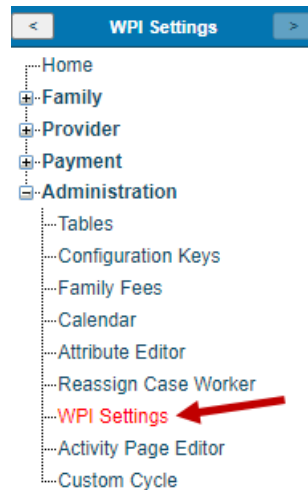
- A** Press **WPI Settings** under **Administration**.

**Note:** The **Page** becomes highlighted to indicate that you are on that page.

- B** Press **Edit**.

- C** The messages are listed in numerical order by ID. Use the corresponding drop-down menu to set the message to **Warn**, **Prevent**, or **Ignore** when information is saved.

- D** Press **Save**.

| ID | Name                          | Description   | Locked | Type    | Parameters             |
|----|-------------------------------|---|--------|---------|------------------------|
| 1  | Password Same As User Name    | When operator's password is same as their username.                           | No     | Ignore  |                        |
| 2  | Password Already In History   | When operator's password has recently been used.                              | No     | Warn    |                        |
| 3  | Password Less Than Min Length | When operator's password contains less than the minimum number of characters. | Yes    | Prevent | Password Min Length: 8 |
| 4  | Password Less Than Min Digits | When operator's password contains less than the minimum number of digits.     | No     | Ignore  | Password Min Digits: 1 |
